AGE endorses global call for action to protect the rights of older people

In view of the third session of the United Nations Open-ended working group on ageing (OEWG) that took place in New York in August 2012, AGE joined forces with other NGOs to call on governments to strengthen legally-binding standards on the rights of older people and develop adequate protection regimes. This document was shared in the OEWG as an advocacy tool and is entitled 'Protecting the Rights of

Germany: creation of an 'Alliance for people with dementia'

On the occasion of World Alzheimer's Day on 21th September 2012 a new "Alliance for People with Dementia" was founded, as a central component of the demographic strategy of the government. The aim is to develop tools and support to people affected by dementia and the promotion of understanding and awareness of dementia in order to counteract social exclusion. 26 local alliances are launched in multigenerational houses – financed by the national government. By 2016, 500 of these nationwide local networks shall arise.
